EdInsight Teacher View Walkthrough

The Teacher View in the EdInsight system is designed to give teachers and classroom supervisors quick access to individual data on the students in their classes as well as aggregate data on class performance as a whole. This walkthrough will highlight the basic functioning of the EdInsight Teacher View.

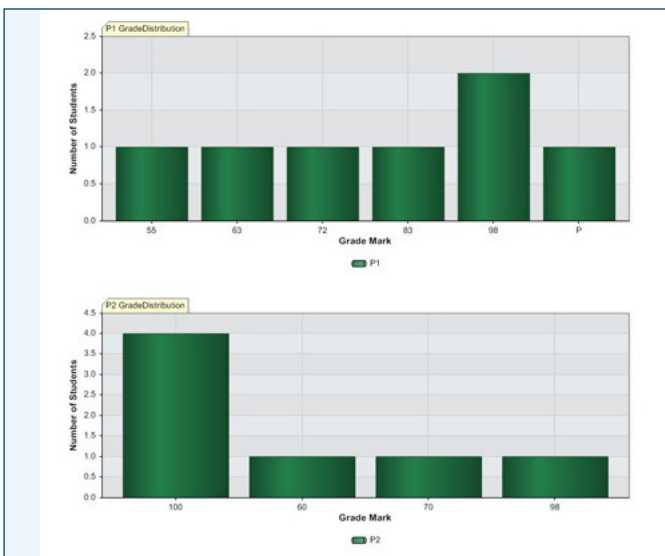
When logged onto the system as a teacher, the first thing encountered is a list of all classes. If a period schedule has been loaded, the classes will be ordered first by 'Today's Classes' (in period order for the day in question), then 'All Classes'. Finally, if historical schedules have been loaded, there will be a link at the bottom of the screen that navigates to a list of last year's classes. This functionality is provided so that the assessment results of students taught the previous year can be tracked. Thus, gauging classroom effectiveness from year to year.

From this view, click on any student to view that student's details. For more information on that view, visit the Student Details Walkthrough. Click on the class name to obtain a more detailed view of the class in question. Clicking on a class will create the view that appears at left.

This view allows access to several pieces of information on the class in question. The tabs across the top of the screen will access grades, assessments, attendance, resources, and curriculum maps for the class.

GRADES



EdInsight imports grade information from the existing student information system. It currently imports and displays marking period, semester, and final exam grades. All grades can be seen in the grid next to the student name.

In addition to a tabular view of the grades, scroll down to find graphs which represent grade distribution for a marking period. This gives the user an idea of the range of grades that their students have earned during a particular marking period.

ASSESSMENTS

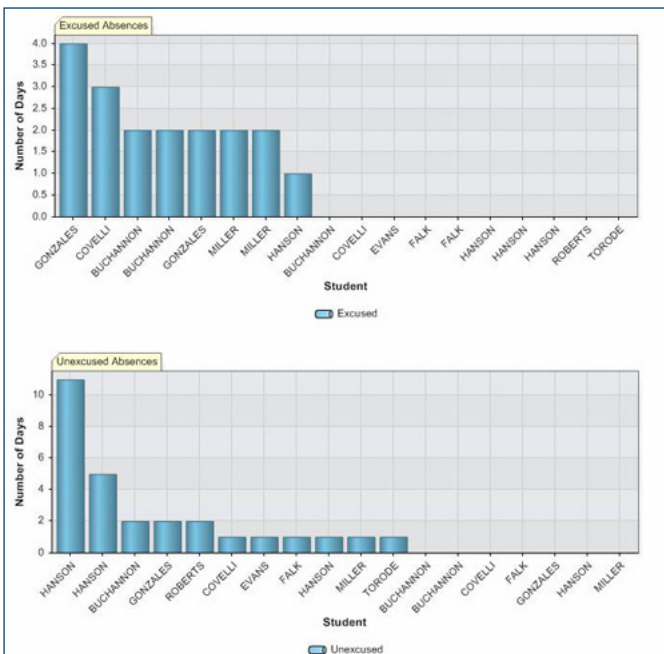
The Assessments tab allows the user to see how your class as a whole has performed on national, state, and benchmark assessments. At first view the assessments tab, no data is displayed.

Click to open the assessments drop down menu and display all assessments that have been taken by at least one student in your class. To view an assessment, select the assessment from the drop-down box and click the 'Show Profile' button.

Clicking on the attendance tab will bring up a view of class attendance, including the number of excused/unexcused absences and excused/unexcused tardies.



Charts that display the number of absences in a visual format, sorted by number of absences are also available in addition to the tabular view.

EdInsight has the ability of storing curriculum maps through the Curriculum Mapper View. Maps generated with this view will appear in the 'curriculum maps' tab of the teacher view. The maps are sorted so that any maps linked directly to that course code are displayed first, and any other district maps are displayed later.

To view one of the curriculum maps on the list, simply click on 'View' next to the curriculum map.

REPORTS | VIEWS

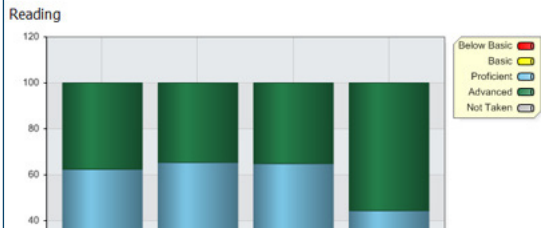
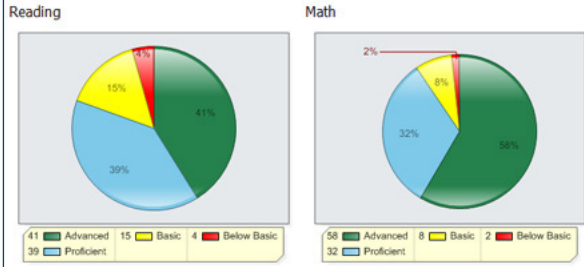

Password is case sensitive and must be eight or more characters, include no spaces, and contain at least one number.

The 'Preferences' tab enables the user to change their password. To change the password, enter the current password once, and a new password twice. The password must be at least eight characters and must contain at least one number. A screen will appear stating that the change has been successful. Any of the tabs can then be clicked to navigate elsewhere throughout the EdInsight system, or select the 'home' button to return to the first screen.
