OnHand Schools will need to know the following from your district to setup the EdInsight system:

1. What Student Information System you are using (SIS).
1. What assessments you currently give. (See Appendix I for what EdInsight supports).
2. Where your Student Information System is housed whether that be in house or not.

Once the required hardware is in place with the necessary software and network requirements:

1. OnHand Schools will need an administrator login to the EdInsight server with terminal services rights. That login will also need access to your student information system database server, but will only need to be able to read the SIS database. If your SIS is housed outside of your district, we will need and ODBC connection to that database.
2. You will need to go to <http://75.145.46.148/dl.asp?id=-1> and install the OnHand Schools monitoring utility.
3. Contact OnHand Schools support at 412-325-8000x2 or support@onhandschools.com and let them know you are ready to set your system up.
4. The support department will need to know the windows login/password, and the name of your server. The OnHand Schools monitoring utility will pick up the IP address and other information.
